We run a Manx Language School

- It's called Bunscoill Ghaelagh.
- It is the world's only Manx medium primary school.
- There are currently 64 pupils.
- It is run by Mooinjer Veggey in conjunction with the Department of Education, Sport & Culture.
- The curriculum is taught entirely through the Manx language.



And two Manx Language Nurseries

- We have one in Ballasalla and one in Braddan.
- There are currently 42 children.
- We cater for two to four year olds.
- Children learn Manx Gaelic through songs and rhymes.
- The children also use limited but regular Manx words and phrases in daily routines.



And a Manx Language Parents & Tots group

- It is called Possan Cloie
- Children and parents learn and use Manx language through activities, songs and rhymes.
- We meet in St. Johns on Monday mornings during term time.



All promoting the Manx Language!

- Mooinjer Veggey was formed in 1996
- It has been promoting Manx Gaelic ever since.
- Our aim is to provide education with, or through, the Manx language, giving children the advantages of learning a second language at an early age.



We are also an educational charity!

Mooinjer Veggey is an educational charity which exists to promote the knowledge and use of Manx Gaelic among young people.
